The two-day national conference on climate-resilient construction has commenced at SPA Bhopal.

Manmohan Vaidya, a member of the All India Executive Board of the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS), was the chief guest at the opening session. In his inaugural speech, he emphasized the importance of spirituality in sustainable living. Prof. H.D. Charan, Chair of SPA Bhopal's Board of Governors, welcomed the dignitaries and participants, while SPA Bhopal Director Kailasa Rao extended a vote of thanks. On the first day, the conference focused on three thematic areas: 1) Climate-Resilient Design and Planning, 2) Traditional Knowledge and Sustainability, and 3) Environmental Psychology and Sustainable Development. Discussions covered various topics such as biogas, sustainable development of tribal communities, sustainable living, water sustainability, regenerative design, traditional knowledge, environmental psychology, and waste management.
