

China Offered Arms to Sheikh Abdullah in 1960s: Omar

Srinagar: Former chief minister of J&K, Omar Abdullah on Thursday claimed that Chinese leadership offered National Conference founder Sheikh Abdullah, to launch an armed rebellion in the state in 1960's, which he refused. Abdullah stated that Chinese leader Chou-Enlai, made the offer during a Conference in Algeria, in presence of Algerian leader, Ahmed Ben Bella, who desisted Sheikh Abdullah from accepting the offer.

During Algerian Conference, the Chinese leader Chou-Enlai offered full support to Sher-e-Kashmir Sheikh Mohammad Abdullah to launch an armed revolt in the state. But he did not accept the offer. He didn't want youth of state to suffer," said Abdullah, while addressing a youth convention of the party in Srinagar.

Abdullah informed that Bella took Sheikh Abdullah to a graveyard and showed him the grave of his son. Bella told Sheikh

Abdullah, that all Kashmiris are your sons. If you want to burry your sons like this, then only you can accept this (chinese) offer," said Abdullah


Prashant Kishor to Pen Book on **How to Win, Lose Elections**

Srinagar: Jammu and Kashmir police have arrested a 50-year-old paedophile faith healer, who has allegedly abused several hundred children over last 15 years, in Sopore, 50kms from Srinagar in north Kashmir.

The accused identified as Aijaz Ahmad Sheikh, was arrested on Thursday morning on complaint of a child, who has allegedly suffered abuse for around four years. Sheikh is married and has three children including two boys and a girl.

BJP Cell for Fast-tracking Grant of Citizenship to Hindus

Kolkata: Six months after the government issued a notification stating that minority refugees from Pakistan and Bangladesh can stay in the country even after their visas expire, a BJP cell has urged the government to expedite the citizenship Bill for Hindu refugees ahead of the Assam and West Bengal elections.

The BJP refugee cell requested the government also to start granting citizenship to the Hindu refugees under Section 18 of the Citizenship Act. In a recent letter to union home minister Rajnath Singh, the cell said it doesn't want a "general amnesty' type arrangement for these refugees. Instead, it has proposed that a reason be stated for the exodus from Bangladesh, based on which the citizenship be given. These documents. according to them, will then be used to form a public opinion about the atrocities of an Islamic society on the Hindus in Bangladesh, which in turn will help bring "legal and financial assistance" from international fora. The Citizenship Amendment Bill was introduced by the home ministry last year and the government has invited comments from public. Home ministry officials said the process of consultation is still ongoing and that is not tabled before they will come up with a Cabinet note as soon as the decision is reached. Talk Date After Pathankot Probe Report

New Delhi: India is waiting for progress in Pakistan's investigation into the January terror attack on Indian Air Force base at F Pathankot in Punjab before rescheduling Foreign Secretary S Jaishankar's meeting with his counterpart AA Chaudhry.

Sources here said that India had asked Pakistan to inform it about the SIT's visit at least five days ahead of its arrival. Islamabad, however, had not yet shared with New Delhi any information about the proposed visit.

On Wednesday, addressing Raisina Dialogue — India's major foreign policy Dialogue — Foreign Secretary S Jaishankar made it clear that terror attack like Pathankot will take precedence over political dialogue.

Meanwhile, MEA spokesperson Vikas Swarup giving details of attack on Indian consulate in Afghanistan, said, "Our Consulate in Jalalabad came under attack by a group of 5 terrorists at 12 noon. The attackers approached the Consulate in a van rigged with explosives...No member of the Consulate was injured except superficial injuries in right hand of one of the local staff members. Three persons reportedly died in the attack. National Directorate of

fused to give in to Pachauri's demands, he stopped giving him work. That she felt harassed and intimidated, the complainant has said that she used to hide in the bathroom whenever Pachauri used to come for rounds in office.
